 1. What clubs do we have?

- d. Holiday Spirit at NES

 1. Concern over the joy being taken away from the season when children stress each morning of the week to find an outfit
 2. Easy themes (show your socks day, wear your pajamas day, clothes inside out and backwards day) for higher participation from those who may not have as much support from home
 - a. Admin will talk with counsellors about this as they may already have it planned and shared out. But this may not be something that we can change this year, but next year. We can also talk about the themes and see if they can be simplified for families as well. These are great suggestions that will be communicated with counsellors.
- e. AAFES Lunch
 - i. How much say do we have, if any?
 1. Repetitive. Especially for those with dietary restrictions
 - a. We have no say in anything with AAFES. We always try and communicate concerns with them, but we really have no control over any of it. Ms. Muzzy will also share concerns with the newly hired supervisors. We also see the concern when there are changes. Ms. Muzzy suggested concerns should begin with the cafeteria manager.
 - i. Parents have special concerns with UPK because they have children who have restrictions, and they cannot send food with the student, but the student is having to eat the same thing every couple days.
 1. Admin said there are always special circumstances for medical reasons that

policies can have exceptions. Please just communicate this with the school and we can look into those situations.

3. Non-Agenda Items:

- a. Ms. Muzzy wanted to discuss the soldier support before and after school.
 - i. We need soldier support inside the gate at pick up to assist with the flow of traffic. This is especially helpful for the safety on foggy days.
 - 1. Ms. Muzzy will see if she can reach out and see which unit is coming to support so we can request the inside support and find out who the POC is for this support.
