2. Follow-Ups from 22 September Meeting

- a. Clubs have now begun- Clubs are in full swing at Netzaberg Elementary School 😊
- b. School-wide Recycling Program
 - i. Who else can we email?-
 1. David Johnson was emailed but he indicated that due to budget constraints we are unable to incorporate an additional program at this time. However, we can invite environmental on base and have them come out to speak and present to students to encourage them and get them excited for recycling.
